How to enjoy the 40 days

SET aside significant time to seek God in prayer and fasting. It may be half-an-hour or one hour. During that special time, practice <u>Worship</u> and Word.

WORSHIP.

Play your favourite CD or tape. Sing along to the Lord.

WORD.

Read aloud the Word according to the passages assigned for each day in this prayer guide.

Pray the Word! Arise in faith, and in the authority of Jesus' Name, claim the promise and power of His Word which is alive and active!

Adopt an attitude of prayer as you go about each day's duties at home, at work or at school. Apply what you learn from the Word into tangible actions.

Scale down your normal activities. Slow down. Avoid rigorous exercise such as jogging. Besides fasting from food, fast from things that distract such as TV, movies, Internet, computer games; including careless words.

Break fast gradually and wisely. For health reasons, you should consume small portions as you break fast, avoid chilli or acidic foods as much as possible.

How to fast

YOU are free to fast however the Spirit leads you. Here are some options:

TOTALFAST

Abstain from solid food for 24 hours. Take only water.

1-MEAL FAST

Sacrifice one full meal a day. For example: Lunch or Dinner.

PARTIAL FAST

Abstain from solid food for any extended part of the day e.g., sunrise to sundown. Take only water.

DANIEL FAST

Abstain from meat and other favourite delicacies. Take only small portions of fresh vegetables, fruit and juices.

How to involve others

FAMILY FAST

Agree to fast and pray as a family.

Decide on the type of fast every member of your household is comfortable with. For family devotion, read and pray the Word given for the day.

CELL GROUP FAST

Fasting together as a group is easier than doing it alone. Obtain copies of this 40-Day prayer guide from NECF. Choose a specific type of fast. Schedule a specific time each day for cell members to synchronize prayers as they fast. Gathered in ONE accord, practice the 2 Ws (Worship and Word).



Yearn for personal and national revival. Cry for God's visitation in your cell group and community!

OFFICE FAST

Inspire a few Christian colleagues to fast with you. For example, utilize tea breaks or lunch breaks in the office to fast and pray through the prayer items assigned for that day together.

TRIPLET FAST

With the blessing of your Pastor/
Care Group leader, organize
Christian homemakers of your
housing area into prayer and
fasting triplets. Aim to meet once
a week for at least an hour of
praying through the 40-Day
Prayer and Fast Booklet.

Reconciliation of hearts of our fathers to the children and vice versa

Against spirit of hurt, resentment and abandonment

Fathers arise to take spiritual headship and be the Bible teacher in the family

Men to keep their promise to the family - be truthful, honest, trustworthy and faithful

Biblical standards be adopted into laws of the land

Total deliverance from greed, corruption and prejudices

S CRIPTURE: 2 CHRON 6 -7

REPENTEROM:

Pray:

Church to be God's instruments for change.

Church will ride with the winds of change and adapt as the Spirit leads

Open doors for the gospel to reach all

The Grind and the Groan

After 400 years of oppression in Egypt, the Hebrews groaned. The situation seemed bleak—enslaved to a system where, day in and out they were forced to make bricks under the scorching sun to fulfill a national agenda: make Egypt great. However, God heard their cries. No eloquent speeches. No clever tagline. No proven formula. Just a groan. God was moved and He said, "Let My people go!"

Pray:

For today's workforce to be delivered from work-addiction that disrupts lives and destroys families

Renewal and change of systems of work that "enslaves" and harasses workers. Cry to Jesus to act on our behalf.

For justice for blue collar and foreign low skilled workers who have to work long hours, low pay and no benefits

UACT:

Write a 'thank you' or appreciation card to your boss, peer or subordinate expressing something they have contributed to in your life.

Disciple a young working adult to make godly choices in his/her life.

S CRIPTURE: PHIL 1:20-21

Dethroning Self

Modern societies have been breeding a generation of "feel good" youth: self-centered, aimless and without a cause. Jesus had a cause to live for—save the world. That cause needs to be in the hearts and minds of all our children and youth.

Pray:

Submission: Renounce all worldly securities that have hindered children and youth from following Christ fully. Ask God to search hearts and show us what is "lacking" in our commitment to Him.

Obedience: Ask God to birth a new generation of selfless leaders and believers who will pledge allegiance to Him in wholehearted devotion and listen, obey and do His Will.

Singlemindedness: Pray that this generation of SELFLESS youth will be single-minded to follow Him. Make His Commission the highest priority and fulfill His purpose to the end.

Sent out: Cry out for the release of youth who will not love their lives unto death into the harvest fields both locally and abroad. Generation of selfless pioneers to reach the remaining 500 unreached people groups.

DECLARE

"For me to live is Christ! To die is gain!" (Phil 1:21)

UACT:

PER ECTION

Call up a young person today and express interest in that individual's plans and future.
Offer help and support all the way. Encourage our youth for Christ. Don't criticise them!

Pray:

- God will exchange our hearts of stone for hearts of flesh to obey His commands
- Our eyes will be renewed to that of eagles' with keenness to spot those in whom God is already at work
- Our ears will be finely tuned to hear conversations of friends and colleagues that have a cry for help amidst superficial laughter
- Our hearts will ache when we see our friends lost and without hope
