What are the factors that will derail a leader and diminish his or her effectiveness and credibility? What are the temptations that leaders are most susceptible to? In this workshop, we will look at how spiritual disciplines and accountability will help leaders keep focused, stay alert and be consciously dependent on God in moments of trial and temptation.

#### W3 Workshop Session 3: Leadership Emotional Health ELIZABETH LEE / BILLY CHAN

Burnt out or on the way to burn out? Stressed out and worn out? Stuck and not seeing the kind of growth in your own life nor in the life of your organization or church? In this workshop you will explore and experience the whole gospel for the whole person in a practical and life changing way - a strategy for discipleship that integrates emotional maturity and spiritual integrity for leaders.
