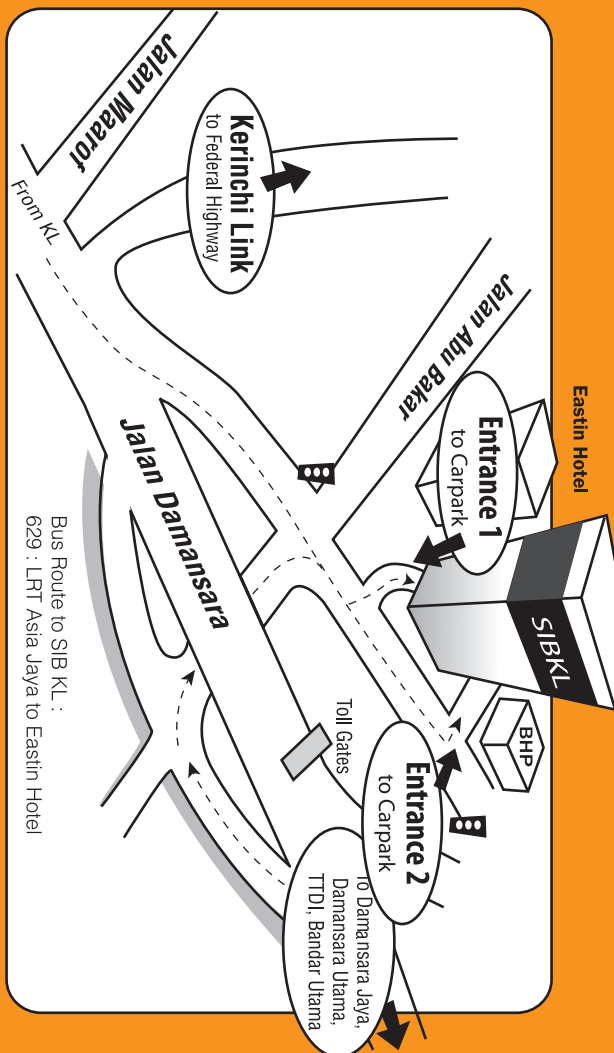

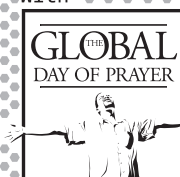

Graham is also the founder of Unashamedly Ethical, and he now heads his company to promote values, ethics and clean living across all sectors of society.

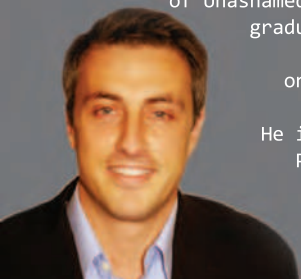


DR DION FORSTER is a marketplace-minister and academic. He is the former Dean of John Wesley College, the seminary of the Methodist Church of Southern Africa.
