The Merlimau state constituency has 10,679 registered voters with the Malays being the majority representing 10,088 of the total (71%), followed by 2,752 Chinese (19.4%), 1,314 Indians (9.2%) and 61 others (0.4%)

There are six mosques, surau (20), Chinese shrine (5), temple (6) and two churches. One of which is Merlimau Chinese Methodist Church

Kerdau has 8,999 registered voters including 15 postal. They comprise of 89 percent Malays, 6 per cent Chinese, 3.7 percent Indians and 2.5 percent other races.

There are no churches in Kerdau . One Chinese temple and the rest are mosques and suraus. PM has promised funds (100k) to build an Indian temple for the Indian community
